

What is CLEP?

The College-Level Examination
Program (CLEP) offers **34 exams** that
cover intro-level college course
material.

CLEP Exams provide an opportunity to students of all ages to earn college credit for mastery of college-level material.

CLEP Exams



Timed, **computer-based** exams



Students receive immediate score results (with exception of essays)



Exams can be offered whenever a student is ready;
90 day retest



CLEP is scored on a scale from **20 – 80**. ACE recommends college credit at a score of **50**




Over **2900** colleges and universities award credit for CLEP

University cost for 3 credits













Highest Volume CLEP Exams

CLEP Students Are More Likely to Graduate



Passing a CLEP exam correlates to a 5.5% increase in degree completion. This effect is notably strong for student groups who traditionally struggle to graduate:

Students at two-year colleges

Students in the military

Students aged 25 or older

First-generation college-going students

Underrepresented students

High school students who may have missed a college credit granting score in AP use CLEP as an additional opportunity

Heritage speakers

CLEP offers exams in German, French and Spanish and provides the opportunity for students to earn up to 12 credits...

CLEP in non-AP subjects


Many high schools use CLEP as an early college credit opportunity in non-AP subjects like College Algebra or Sociology.

Students seeking to save time

CLEP can be used to meet graduation requirements and free up time in a semester for extra curricular or improved work/life balance.

Students seeking to save money


The cost of CLEP is \$95 and on average earns a student with a passing score 3 college credits which promotes big cost savings for families making college more affordable.



Paying for CLEP exams

CLEP Vouchers

Schools or districts can purchase vouchers to pay for CLEP exams




- Used to pay CLEP exam fee for groups of test takers
- Students enter unique voucher code at time of registration
- No minimum order
- Schools/districts billed only for vouchers used
- Order CLEP vouchers in My CLEP Professional Portal

CLEP Test Centers

Steps to Open CLEP Test Center

- 1. Request CLEP test center application
- 2. Execute CLEP contract
- 3. Train staff who will be administering CLEP through certified learning modules
- 4. Meet with your technical support to implement CLEP

CLEP History of the United States II: 1865 to the Present

AT A GLANCE

Description of the Exam

The History of the United States II: 1865 to the Present exam covers material that is usually taught in the second semester of what is often a two-semester course in United States history. The exam covers the period of United States history from the end of the Civil War to the present, with the majority of the questions on the 20th century.

The exam contains approximately 120 questions to be answered in 90 minutes. Some of these are pretest questions that won't be scored. Any time test takers spend on tutorials and providing personal information is in addition to the actual testing time.

Knowledge and Skills Required

Questions on the History of the United States II exam require candidates to demonstrate one or more of the following abilities:

- · Identify and describe historical phenomena
- Analyze and interpret historical phenomena
- · Compare and contrast historical phenomena

The subject matter of the History of the United States II exam is drawn from the following topics. The percentages next to the main topics indicate the approximate percentage of exam questions on that topic.

30% Political institutions and public policy

30% Social developments

10% Economic developments






