Approval of Minutes

AY 2020 Performance Reports

Sam Christy-Dangermond presented AY 2020 Performance Reports for review. In June 2020, BAASC approved changes to the <u>Performance Agreement: Funding Guidelines</u>, which allow institutions to move up more than one funding level if they identified how the pandemic negatively affected performance indicators. Regent Rolph moved to approve the nine institutions to receive 100% of any new funding for which they are eligible in 2022. Following the second of Regent Schmidt, the motion passed unanimously through a roll call vote.

Regent Rolph moved to table K-State's AAS in Unmanned Aircraft Systems until the February 16, 2022, meeting. Following the second of Regent Winter, the motion passed unanimously through a roll call vote.
