- Credit for Prior Learning (CPL) is credit awarded for learning gained outside of a traditional postsecondary academic environment
- Ideally, the knowledge and skills line up with learning outcomes *for existing courses* at each institution
- Awarding CPL supports the Board's goal to increase higher education attainment among Kansans



Kansas Military Nursing Initiative

- Accelerated "bridge" 68W Army Medic to Registered Nursing program
- Collaborative effort by nursing program leaders at 2 and 4-year institutions
- Approved by the Kansas Board of Nursing -December, 2019
- "Bridge" course content mobile may be taught by multiple nursing programs simultaneously
- Experience translates to actual course credit in nursing programs
- Currently taught at Washburn University, Spring 2020
 - Students at other Kansas nursing programs may enroll through home institution

Lumina Grant Opportunity

- Kansas invited to apply for funding to create new pathways for service members and veterans
- Maximum \$200,000 for 12 month grant period
- Focus on four occupational areas:
 - Supply Administration
 - Combined Personnel and Administration
 - Warehousing and Equipment Handling
 - Food Service
- Provides funding to create innovative pathways leading to stackable credentials which recognize military-based learning
- Pilots selected and applicants notified in June, 2020
