### KSU-Kansas Transitions to Teaching (KTTT)

**Project Summary:** The *Kansas Transitions to Teaching (KTTT)* project assists the transition to elementary teaching of career changers (i.e., people who possess an undergraduate degree and meet admissions criteria) from underserved school districts in Kansas. Six partner school districts assist in recruiting, selecting, and developing teacher candidates. Partnering school districts help to mold the experiences of pre-service teachers to the unique needs of their district. Selected *KTTT* participants receive a *KTTT* Fellowship to be applied toward qualifying education expenses (i.e., tuition, fees, books, and supplies) associated with participation in KSU's Master of Arts in Teaching (MAT) program. *KTTT* Fellows are required to apply to the partnering district upon completion of their program or forfeit their fellowship.

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
