KANSAS PROMISE SCHOLARSHIP ACT

The 2021 Legislature enacted House Bill 2064 creating the new scholarship program and designating the Kansas Board of Regents (Board) as the administrator of the new program. The 2022 Legislature heavily amended the original act in Senate Substitute for House Bill 2567 to clarify legislative intent on the Board's responsibilities, the timing of disbursement of funds to institutions, eligible academic programs, and to revise definitions contained in the Act. The Act was amended again in 2023 Senate Bill 123 to expand the fields of study eligible for scholarship funding and to clarify the maximum scholarship amount for students at eligible private postsecondary institutions.

The Kansas Promise Scholarship Act (Promise Scholarship) provides scholarships for students to attend an eligible postsecondary institution for two-year associate degree programs, career and technical education certificates, or stand-alone programs otherwise identified by the Board, with an expectation that the student obtain a credential in one of those areas and upon completion reside and work in Kansas for at least two years.

PURPOSE OF THE PROGRAM

The purpose of the grant program is to offer Kansans the opportunity to earn a credential in high demand fields, including information technology and security, mental and physical healthcare, advanced manufacturing and building trades, early childhood education and development, and elementary and secondary education, and to provide Kansas industries with the employees they need in these fields.

INSTITUTIONS

Institutions of higher education eligible to participate in the Promise Scholarship program are designated in the legislation. Currently, the participating institutions include:

The Board and the participating institutions partner in administering the Scholarship, as the institutions verify student eligibility, make the awards to eligible students, and create and maintain student-level records with the Board to document satisfaction of the Act's requirements. The students enter into a Promise Scholarship service agreement with the Board and the Board pursues any necessary repayments.

STUDENTS

The requirements for students to qualify for the Kansas Promise Scholarship are as follows:

To be eligible for a Kansas Promise Scholarship award, a student must:

- Be a U.S. citizen and Kansas resident; and
- Have a family household income of:
 - o \$100,000 or less for a family of one or two,
 - o \$150,000 or less for a family of three, or
 - For households larger than three, a household income that is equal to or less than the family of three amount plus \$4,800 for each additional family member; and
- Meet one of the following criteria:
 - Have graduated from a Kansas secondary school within the preceding 12 months; or
 - Have attended a Kansas secondary school and obtained a high school equivalency credential within the preceding 12 months; or
 - Be a Kansas resident for the three years immediately preceding the Promise application as documented by:
 - The date of issuance on a Kansas issued ID;
 - Kansas voter registration records; or
 - Kansas income tax documentation; or
 - Be a dependent child of a military servicemember permanently stationed in another state and, within the preceding 12 months, have graduated from an out-of-state secondary school or obtained a high school equivalency credential; or
 - Have been in the custody of the Secretary for Children & Families at any time during grades 9-12 and not eligible for the waiver benefit under the Kansas Foster Child Educational Assistance Act.

To receive a Kansas Promise Scholarship award (initial or renewal), the student must also:

- Complete the required Kansas Promise Scholarship application; and
- Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA); and
- Enter into a Kansas Promise Scholarship Agreement; and

• Enroll in an eligible program at an eligible institution (may be part-time or full-time but enrolled in at least six hours in any semester of an academic year).

To be eligible to renew a Kansas Promise Scholarship and avoid repayment of the award, the student must maintain satisfactory academic progress toward completion of the Promise Scholarship eligible program—including maintaining a 2.0 GPA; complete the Promise Scholarship eligible program for which the scholarship was awarded within 36 months of the date that the scholarship was first awarded; and otherwise satisfy the requirements of the Scholarship Agreement.

SCHOLARSHIPS

The Kansas Promise Scholarship is a last dollar scholarship. Scholarship recipients have a lifetime limit of 68 credit hours financed with the Promise Scholarship, or a total of \$20,000 in Kansas Promise Scholarship awards—whichever occurs first. Each student has 36 months to complete the Promise eligible program; after the 36-month timeline has been reached, the Student will no longer be eligible for further funding for that program and, if the program was not completed within the 36-month timeline, the student will be required to repay the Promise Scholarship amounts received for that program, with interest, as specified in the Act.

The amount of a Kansas Promise Scholarship for a student is the aggregate amount of tuition, required fees, books, and required materials for the Promise eligible program minus the aggregate amount of other scholarship and grant aid the student is receiving. If enrolled in a Promise eligible program offered by an eligible private postsecondary educational institution, the aggregate award is limited to the average cost of what is charged by a two-year eligible public institution offering the same program.

KANSAS BOARD OF REGENTS DUTIES

The Act required the Board to adopt rules and regulations on or before March 1, 2023, pertaining to:

- A scholarship application process;
- Appeal procedures for denial/revocation of award;
- The terms, conditions and requirements that should be incorporated into each scholarship agreement, which cannot be more stringent than those in the Promise Act;
- Procedures for requesting and approving medical, military and personal absences from eligible institutions while receiving the scholarship; and
- Criteria for determining if a student fulfilled residency, employment and repayment requirements.

The Board adopted the final regulations at its February 15-16, 2023 meeting.

The Kansas Promise Scholarship Act also requires the Board to identify the eligible programs offered by the eligible institutions that are in the following fields of study:

- Information technology and security;
- · Physical and mental health care;
- Early childhood education and development, elementary education and secondary education:
- Advanced manufacturing and building trades; or
- One additional field of study per eligible institution to meet local employment needs as listed below if:
 - Promise-eligible programs within such field of study are associate degree programs or career and technical education certificates or stand-alone programs approved by the Board that correspond to jobs that are high wage, high demand or critical need in the community; and
 - The institution already offers such field of study; and
 - o The field of study is one of the following:
 - agriculture;
 - food and natural resources;
 - education and training;
 - law, public safety, corrections and security; or
 - transportation, distribution and logistics.

The Board may designate an associate degree transfer program only if such program is in:

- An established 2+2 agreement with any Kansas four-year institution; or
- An articulation agreement with a Kansas four-year institution and part of an established degree pathway in which the student transfers at least 60 credit hours for the completion of an additional 60 credit hours toward a bachelor's degree.

Eligible programs are listed here on the Board's website at https://www.kansasregents.org/students/student_financial_aid/promise-act-scholarship where each institution has a linkable document with approved programs.

The Act also requires the Board to:

- Work with community partners to publicize the Promise Scholarship program;
- Develop guidelines to help ensure courses are transferrable;
- Disburse funds to each institution:
- Request information from each institution and any state agency necessary to administer the program;
- Enforce scholarship agreements;
- Collect any repaid scholarship funds;
- Determine whether scholarship recipients fulfilled the residency, employment and repayment requirements; and
- Annually evaluate the Promise Scholarship program and report to the standing education committees of the House of Representatives and the Senate.

The participating institutions market the Kansas Promise Scholarship on their websites, on their social media accounts and to local news outlets. Potential employers and high schools also promote the scholarship on social media.

DATA COLLECTIONS

In total, there were 1,843 Promise Act recipients in AY 2023 and 790 recipients completed a program.

The tables that follow provide student enrollment and wage data, as well as enrollments by program and institution in AY 2023.
